I am the community line development officer for the 1066 Hastings to Tonbridge Line for Southeast Communities Rail Partnership CIC. We are a non-profit organisation who are working to join communities up with their stations and railway and make them welcoming places to be. At Robertsbridge Station you already have some very attractive gardens and planters which have been created by Southeastern ticket office staff member Ross in his own time, local volunteers and members of the 'Incredible Edibles' group. Ross and the volunteers are again this year, hoping to put on and maintain a lovely floral display.
