Hope you had a good Christmas and are fully prepared for the New Year

I am writing to ask for help from the Parish Council. The Club is applying for a grant from Rother District Council under there Community Grant Scheme to help pay for insulation and double glazing to our members bar wall. Now it has no insulation just a cavity sandwiched between wooden feather boarding and internal plaster board. The existing glazing is all single. Our application has been submitted already and we have been asked to show evidence of Community Support, particular the Parish Council. Would it be possible to get a letter or e mail from The Parish Council re-affirming The Club as a Community Asset as detailed in the 2018 Neighbourhood plan and that you support The Clubs initiative to reduce the amount of gas it uses to heat the building by reducing the heat loss and reducing the noise breakout through the walls and windows. Thus, improving the environmental credentials of The Club.

We have applied for a grant of approximately £17K. of which the RDC would possibly award us half, so we would be looking for additional support as well as funds from within our organisation. I would ask for some financial support as well as the written support, the value of that grant is of your choosing. I understand the financial award would have to go to full council but would ask that the letter of support be drafted under executive powers as soon as possible as I need to get this additional evidence back to RDC in January.
