

Report of Robertsbridge Community Association taken and précised from the June meeting minutes held on 29th June 2023

The cost of the new floor was £25980.00 and was paid for out of the hall funds. Because of the size of the transaction it will be reported to the Charities Commission as an extraordinary expenditure that was needed to maintain the fabric and use of the hall.

The Solar Panel survey has been received and they wait for confirmation of the grant allocation from Rother District Council. In the mean time they are questioning the survey results especially the financial figures used.

The Hearing Loop will be re-installed once the skirting has been finished by the floor contractor

Predicted annual water charge is £750 which will be questioned and a figure agreed.

New Hall Hire Charges have been rolled out with very little complaint from users. Operational costs have increased and must be reflected in charges

The dangerous state of the drain manhole outside the front gate has been reported to highways and cones have been lent to designate a hazard to pedestrians. So far only one cone went missing, but was retrieved from the hedge and re-instated

The youth club has changed its day to Monday rather than Tuesday in an attempt to boost attendances. *(The Parish will investigate how we can help in increasing the attendance numbers)*

The stolen tables will be replaced under the hall insurance.

There is one allotment still available and it will be advertised locally.

The broken entrance barrier has been repaired and new lock and keys acquired.

Dean, the local vagrant, has re-appeared in the village and may try to take up residence in and around the hall. Vigilance will be required
