Rother Association of Local Councils	Clerk, David Todd Meets quarterly, April, July, October and January. Normally Wednesday afternoon in Battle but still sometimes on zoom in daytime or evening Can appoint two Reps but only one can vote. Clerk can be voting Rep. Clerks can also attend as non-voting participants (in addition to Reps).	
East Sussex Association of Local Councils Ltd. (ESALC)	Roger Palamarczuk, Sean O'Hara - Each Council must appoint two Representatives to attend, speak and vote (1 vote each) at the ESALC AGM. - Clerks can attend AGM, but cannot speak or vote, so cannot be Rep. - Can appoint (at a meeting by resolution) a proxy voter – carries the vote only - no right to speak (so could be the Clerk). Councils are expected to appoint REPS who <u>will be</u> available to attend the AGM (held in October <u>in the daytime!</u>)	MUST HAVE TWO
